What is Ronald McDonald House Charities?

Studies show children heal faster and cope better when their families are near. Since 1982, seriously ill children and their families have found strength in numbers through the programs of Ronald McDonald House Charities of North Central Florida (RMH). RMH provides a “home away from home” for 31 families each night by providing a private room and all the comforts of home.
